393 Main Street · The House at 393 Main Street Owner: John, Sandy and Ashley O'Brien The lot at 393 Main Street was owned by Mary Ada Harding who built her home there in 1910. It remained a private residence until 1989 when it was purchased by Harriet and David Van Sickle who converted the property to commercial use as a real estate office.

The present owners purchased the house in 2013 and decided the house needed a total renovation. A great deal of the original home was retained, including the hardwood floors, door casings, moldings and two stained glass windows. The original chimney was repaired, and the front porch and the original staircase were retained. New cedar shingles and new shutters were installed, and an addition to the rear has a sunroom and a new bathroom.

The lot was landscaped and the resulting property is bright and attractive, as well as being historically appropriate.
